Our mission is to ensure the voice of Americans living overseas is heard by policy makers in Washington, D.C. on domestic and foreign affairs, which directly affect the security and welfare of American citizens abroad.

The US State Department estimates there are 8 million+ Americans living overseas (excluding military).

If the Americans living overseas were a state, it would be the 13th largest state in the US, between Virginia and Washington.

Why a PAC?

All too often members of the American overseas community are not allowed a seat, let alone a voice, at the policy table. American citizens living overseas feel forgotten and left out of the process.

AVI PAC seeks to fill this democratic gap and provide Americans living overseas a place at the policy making table.

A Political Action Committee (PAC) allows for direct engagement in the democratic process through:

- events to educate the community on issues of concern
- dialogue with policy makers and leaders in Washington
- fund-raising to further the cause of the PAC
- allocation of funds for a common goal

Focus on voter registration

Voices must be used to be heard. AVI focuses on voter registration of Americans living overseas to ensure this democratic right is exercised.

We conduct outreach via social media and in-person to help Americans streamline the sometimes cumbersome process of registering to vote from abroad.

How is AVI different from other organizations overseas?

AVI is not aligned with any political party. We focus on the concerns and interests of Americans overseas.

As a PAC, AVI actively supports candidates who listen to the American voices overseas with campaign donations. We also allocate funds to promote and educate on the issues that concern Americans overseas.
